

PROJECT: HEART SACHET

Just in time for Valentines' Day! Make someone's day with this very cute and quick In-the-hoop heart sachet. Or (as I have been 'ordered') – change the wording to an initial, add some lavender to the stuffing, and put them in the girls draws so their clothes smell nice.

Finished Size – 5x5 inch



Materials

Two 6x6 inch squares of fabric
Piece of Ribbon
Small amount of stuffing
Tear-away stabiliser

EMBROIDERY

Download heart sachet design to your machine

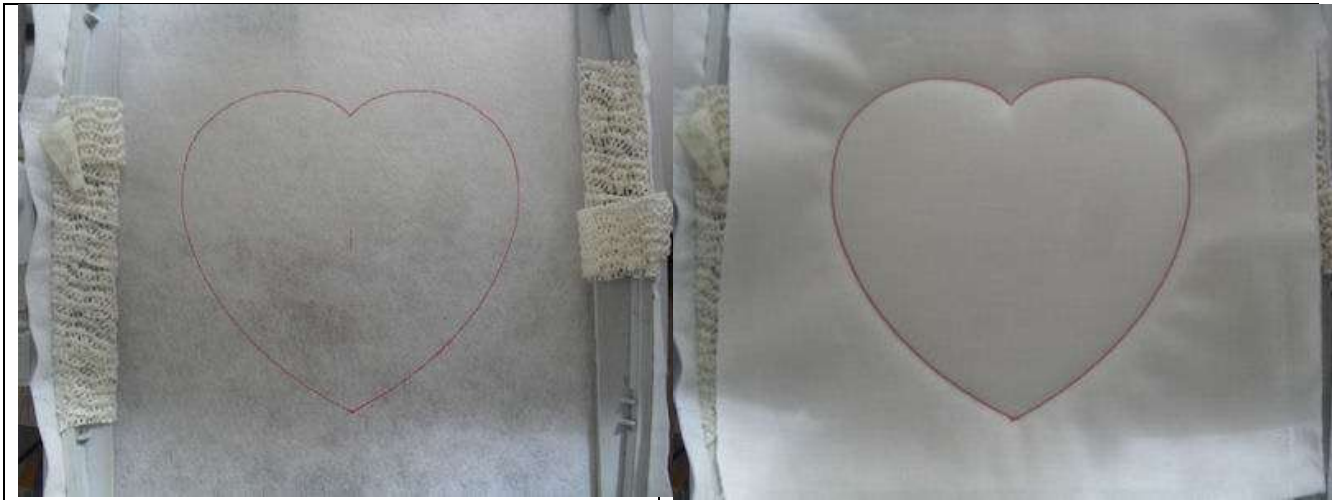
Hoop Tearaway Stabiliser

Thread your machine with a neutral color – *I used red so it shows in photos*

Stitch Color 1 This is the placement line for the heart front

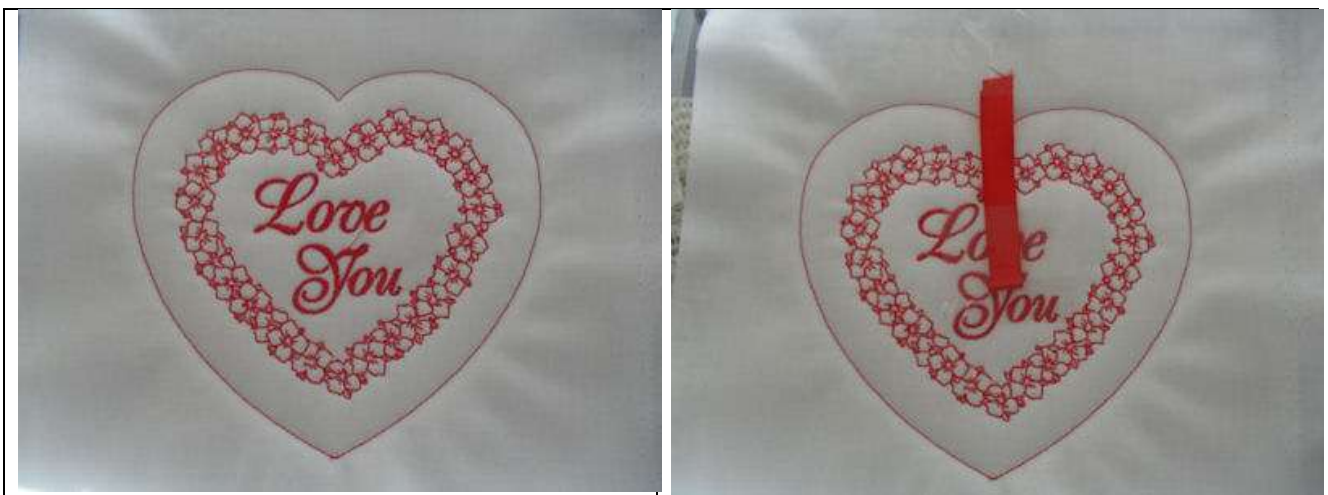
Ensure your fabric covers all edges of the placement line

Stitch Color 2 This attaches the fabric



Change Thread Color to Red

Stitch Color 3 and 4 which is your embroidery design



Fold ribbon piece in half ensuring the folded edge is placed towards the middle of the heart

Tape in place

Place back fabric (with right-side facing the heart)



Stitch Color 5

This attaches the back fabric and zig zags the edge (oops missed that step in this photo!!)

Turn heart inside out.

Press

Add small amount of stuffing and/or lavender

Hand-sew the raw edge shut!!
