



Nothing fancy with this one — just a super quick little Halloween project that adds a touch of handmade fun to an ordinary lollipop!

Made from felt and stitched completely in the hoop, these little Lollipop Holders are perfect for Halloween treats for the kids, grandchildren, classmates, neighbours or trick-or-treaters.

I've included the **TREAT** wording shown in my samples, or you can easily personalise the design by adding a child's name or your own wording.

Best of all, they're a great scrap-buster! Dig into those little pieces of felt you can never quite bring yourself to throw away.

The design fits a 4x4 hoop, and you can stitch three at a time in one hooping, making it easy to create a whole batch of Halloween treats quickly.

Sometimes the simplest projects are the most fun — add a lollipop and you're done! 🍬 🍭

FINISHED SIZE

Each holder is:

- 2.8 by 9.6 cms
- 1 by 3.7 inches

MATERIALS FOR HOLDERS

- 2 layers of water-soluble fabric-type stabiliser
- Matching bobbin thread
- 3 Pieces of 5x5 inch felt

I used Felt for my Lollipop Holders because I love how quick and easy it makes this little project — simply stitch, trim and you're done!

However, because the design has a fully enclosed satin stitch edge, you are not limited to felt.

You can also use cotton fabric. Simply trim the front and back fabrics close to the stitching before completing the final satin stitch edge for a neat, clean finish.

For the pocket, you can use felt or a piece of folded cotton fabric, so there are no raw edges to worry about.

Feel free to use what you have in your stash — this is a great little design for using up those smaller scraps of felt and fabric.

STABILISER AND HOOPING

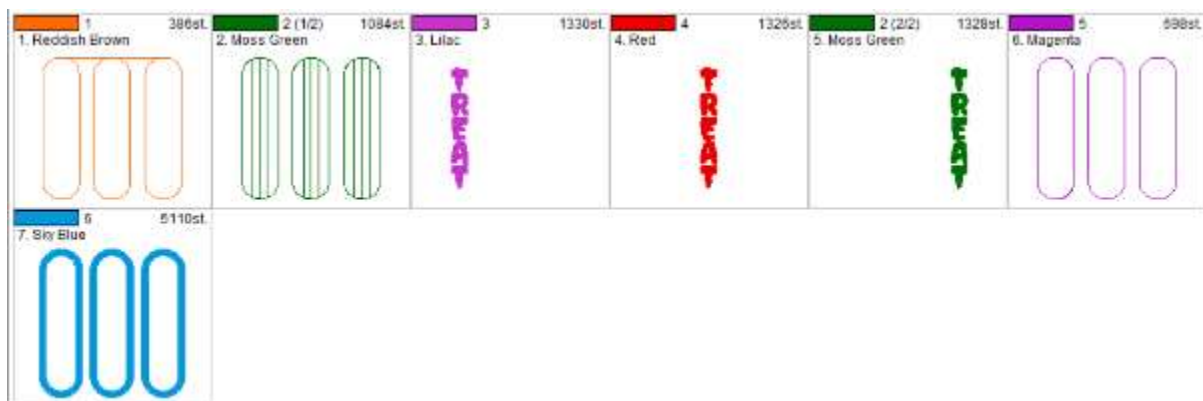


Hoop stabiliser

Use pins at the hoop edge to ensure no stabiliser movement

CONSTRUCTION



If you are new to this technique – please watch the **quick video** on the product page (about halfway down the page)

STEP ONE – THE FABRIC PLACEMENT LINE



Thread your machine with a neutral colour

Stitch Colour 1, which is the outline of the holders and shows you where to place your fabric

STEP TWO – FABRICS



Thread machine with colour you want for the background quilting

Place felt over the guideline

Stitch Color 2 to attach felt and stitch the background quilting (orange)



Stitch wording

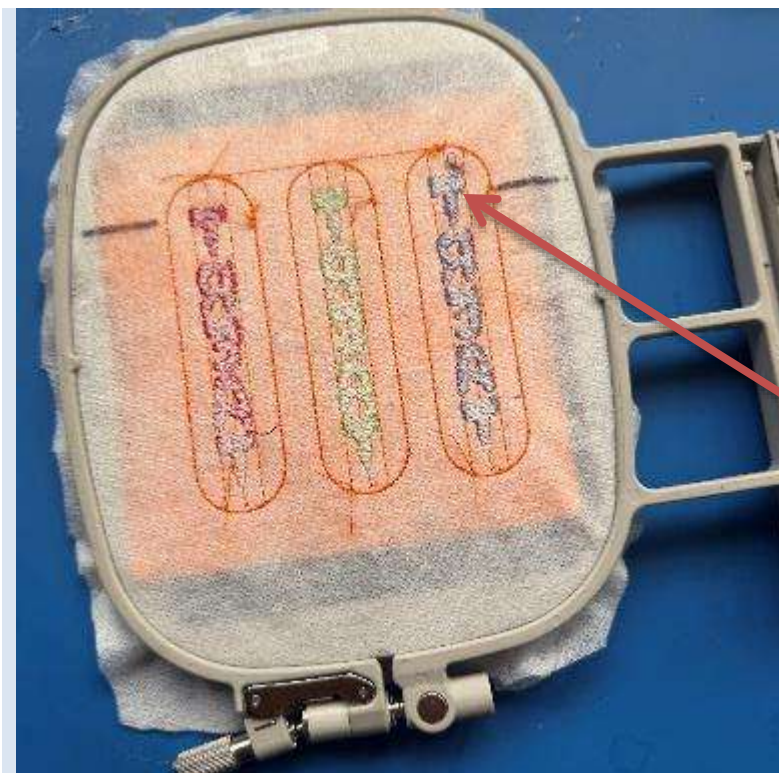
Color 3 – purple

Color 4 – Green

Colour 5 – Red

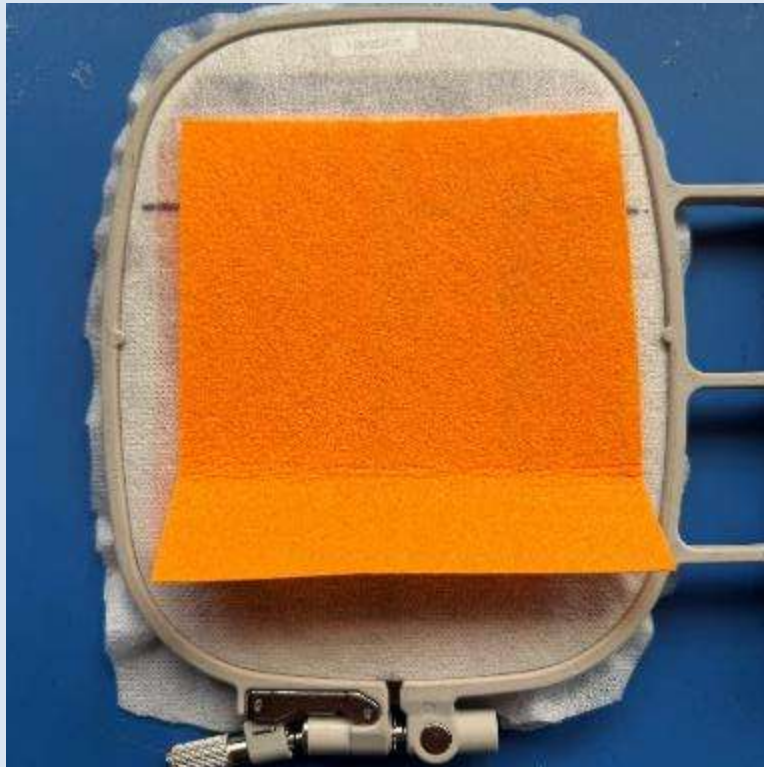
STEP THREE- ADD BACKING FABRIC AND POCKET



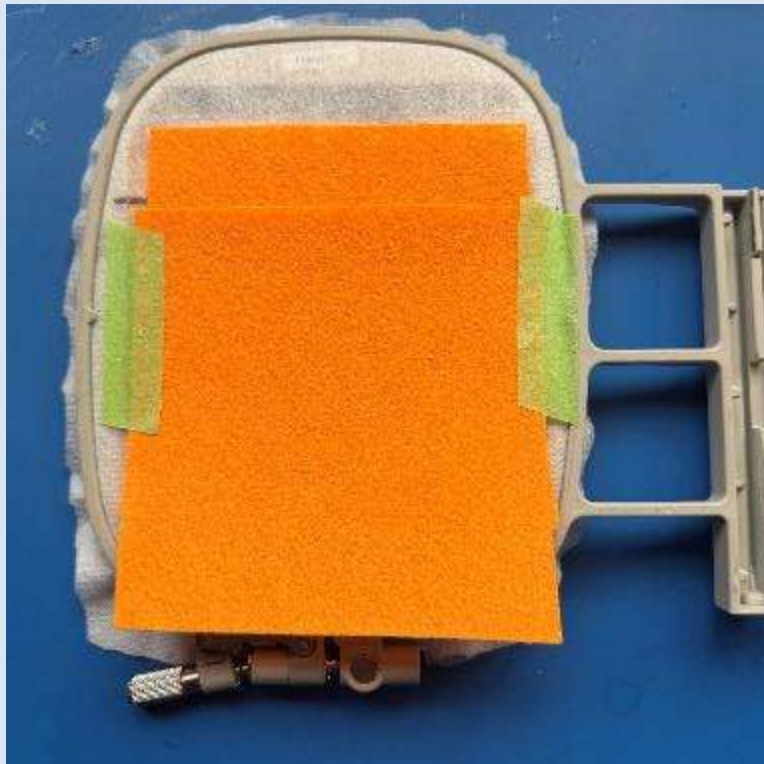
BACK OF HOOP

Use a pen to mark pocket placement.

I placed the top of the pocket just under the top of the T



Place full piece of felt
over the entire
guideline



Place the 2nd piece of
backing fabric with the
top edge positioned to
your marks

Tape in place

STEP FOUR – ATTACH FABRICS



Stitch Colour 6 to attach the backing fabrics

Change bobbin thread to match

Stitch Colour 7 to complete the satin stitch edge

STEP FIVE – FINISH



Remove the design from the hoop and trim away the excess stabiliser and fabrics from the edges

Add your Lollipops
