FINISHED SIZE

12.5 X 17 cms

5 X 6.7 inches

MATERIALS FOR COASTERS

- 2 layers of fabric type water soluble stabiliser
- Matching bobbin thread
- 2 pieces of 6 x 8-inch fabric
- 1 piece of 6 x 8-inch batting

****If you wish to strengthen the trophy, I would suggest using felt or bag batting in place of batting, or use the felt as a backing fabric**

STABILISER AND HOOPING

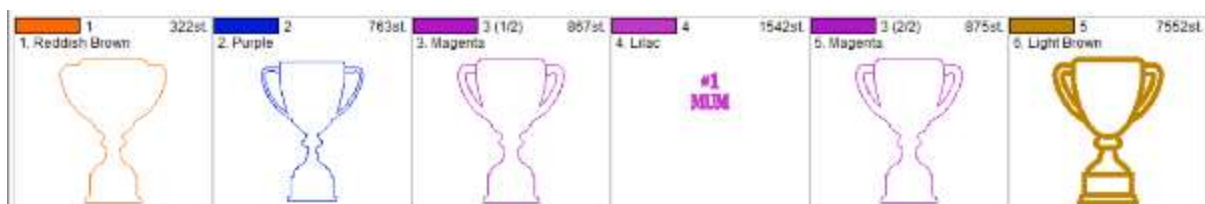


Hoop 2 layers of fabric type water soluble stabiliser

Use pins at the hoop edge to ensure no stabiliser movement

CONSTRUCTION



STEP ONE – THE FABRIC PLACEMENT LINE



Thread your machine with a neutral colour

Stitch Colour 1, which is the outline of the coaster and shows you where to place your fabric

STEP TWO – BATTING



Set your batting over the guideline and tape in place

Stitch Colour 2 to attach



Cut away excess
batting

There are gaps
between the batting
and original outline –
this keeps the batting
out of the edges

STEP THREE – FRONT FABRIC



On the front of the
hoop, place the trophy
fabric over the
guideline

Stitch Colour 3 to
attach fabric



Stitch Colour 4 – the included lettering

Skip this colour if you wish to add your own lettering

Want to add your own lettering?

Now's the perfect time — before you add your backing fabric. The method you use will depend on your embroidery machine or software. If you're unsure where to start, we've put together a **general guide to adding lettering** – [Click here to read the Blog Post](#).

STEP FOUR – ADD BACKING FABRIC

BACK OF HOOP

Remove hoop from the machine

As pictured, use small pieces of tape to hold the backing fabric in place, return hoop to machine

Wrong side of fabric facing the hoop





Return hoop to the machine

Stitch Colour 5 to attach your backing fabric

STEP FIVE – CUT AWAY EXCESS FABRIC

Remove hoop from the machine and, with sharp scissors, cut away excess fabric front and back



STEP SIX – COMPLETE EMBROIDERY



Change bobbin thread to match top thread for your satin stitch

Stitch Colour 6 which completes the zigzag and satin stitch edge (silver)

STEP SEVEN – FINISHING



Cut away the excess stabiliser around the edges

Use a cotton bud/Q-tip and warm water to dissolve any stabiliser left on the edges


To completely remove all traces of stabiliser, soak or place coaster in washing machine. Once dry and pressed the coaster is like new
