



IN THE HOOP STRAWBERRY COASTER INSTRUCTIONS



Add some bright Summer Color to your Table when you stitch these in the hoop Strawberry Coasters

FINISHED SIZE

5x7 Hoop	6X10Hoop	8x8 Hoop	8x10 Hoop
5 by 6 inches	6 by 7.5 inches	6.5 by 7.5 inches	8 by 9 inches

MATERIALS

Fabric Usage is dependent on your hoop size.

- Water Soluble Stabiliser 2 layers
- Sharp Scissors

	5X7 Hoop	6X10 Hoop	8X8 Hoop	8x10 Hoop
Red Fabric Batting Backing	One 6x8 piece each	One 7x8.5 piece each	One 7.5x8.5 piece each	One 9x10 piece each
Green Fabric	One 4.5 by 4.5 piece	One 5 by 5.5 piece	One 5.5 by 5.5 piece	One 6.5 by 6.5 piece

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP ONE – Stitch the Fabric Placement Line

- Load design to your Machine
- Thread your machine with a neutral color – We used Red throughout
- Hoop 2 layers of Water Soluble Stabiliser
- Stitch Color 1, which is the Outline of the design, which shows you were to place your fabric
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STEP TWO - Add Fabrics



Place **batting only** over the Guideline

Stitch Color 2 to attach



Place Green Fabric over the Guideline

**If you want to have the fabrics on the back the same as the front, you could place Green Fabric on the back of the hoop

Stitch Color 3 to attach



Cut away excess fabric where the Red fabric will be placed



Place your Red Fabric
over the Guideline

**Same if doing
matching backing

Stitch color 4 to attach



Again, cut away excess
fabric from the top of the
Strawberry

STEP THREE – Stitch Embroidery



Stitch Color 5 – Strawberry seed detail

Skip this color if you don't want to stitch the detail

STEP FOUR - Add Backing Fabric



Float your Backing Fabric
WRONG SIDE OF FABRIC FACING THE HOOP

(With the WSS, you can see the backing fabric and ensure it covers the stitched guidelines completely)

If you are not comfortable floating your backing fabric, you can do as below

Remove your hoop from the machine and as pictured, use small pieces of tape to hold the backing fabric in place, then return hoop to machine

Wrong-side of Fabric facing the hoop



Stitch Color 6 to attach Backing
If you've already added the two-color backing fabrics, you can skip Color 6

STEP FIVE – Remove excess fabric



Remove hoop from Machine and with sharp scissors, cut away excess backing/fabric and Batting (Front and Back)

STEP SIX – Complete Embroidery



Return hoop to Machine

** Optional -Change Bobbin thread to matching Color

Stitch Color 7 which zig zags the raw edges

Color 8 – Red Satin Stitch edge

Color 9 – Green Satin Stitch edge

STEP SEVEN – Finishing



Remove from hoop

Cut away excess stabiliser from the satin stitch edges

Use hot water and a Q-Tip to remove all traces of the Stabiliser on the edges



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
