



## WINE GLASS COASTER INSTRUCTIONS



### 6X10 HOOP

Just under  
6x9 inch

### 5X7 HOOP

Just under  
5x7 inch

Fully reversable  
Wine Glass

I deliberately left the Glass quite plain, so there is plenty of room to add your own wording for Birthdays/Weddings etc

## MATERIALS

- Water Soluble Stabiliser to fit hoop
- 6x8 (7x10) piece of:
  - Thin Pellon/Batting
  - Front Fabric - Glass
  - Backing Fabric - Felt
  - 6x5 (7x6) Fabric - Drink
- Sharp scissors

\*\* optional  
Matching Bobbin thread



## PREPARATION – COASTER



**\*\*Optional**

I used Felt on the back of this Coaster, but you can use normal cotton fabric.

**TIP for Cotton Fabric**

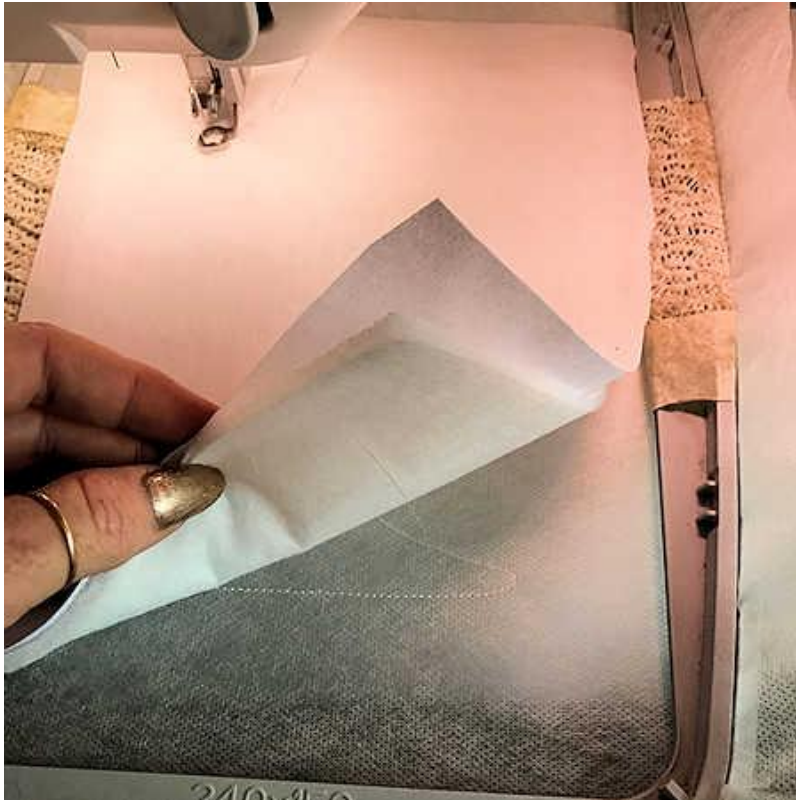
I have been using a very thin iron-on Interfacing on the Coaster backing fabric – it just makes the fabric easier to cut on the back of the hoop, and no threads peeking out of the satin stitch.

## CONSTRUCTION

- Load design to machine
- Hoop 2 layers of Water Soluble Stabiliser
- Thread machine with a neutral color



Stitch Color 1 – the outline of the Glass



Place your pellaon/thin  
batting and fabric over  
the Guideline



Stitch Color 2 to attach

\*\* Optional – you could  
cut out the top froth  
piece, If you were  
worried the dark color  
will show thru, or fabric  
is too bulky





Place 'drink' fabric  
over the top  
Guideline

Stitch Color 3 to  
attach

\*\*\*Skip this color if  
you want to stay  
with a one fabric  
design



Change thread to the color you would like for inner glass detail

Skip Color if you wish to leave the Glass plain

Stitch Color 4 – Inner Detail

\*\*\*If you want to add your own wording, add now



As pictured, cut away the white fabric from the top of the Glass



Change thread to  
the 'drink' color  
(white)

Stitch Color 5– Satin  
Stitch Drink Detail

Stitch Color 6 -  
Wording

\*\*\*If you want to  
add your own  
wording, add now





Remove hoop  
from Machine

Tape Backing  
Fabric in place as  
pictured

WRONG-SIDE OF  
FABRIC FACING  
HOOP



Return hoop to  
Machine

Stitch Color 7 to  
attach backing



Remove hoop  
from Machine

Cut away excess  
Fabric on FRONT  
and back of  
hoop



Return hoop to  
Machine

Stitch Color 8 which  
zig zags, the edge,  
and completes the  
Satin Stitch





Remove from hoop

Cut away the excess  
Stabiliser around the  
edges

Use a Cotton Bud/Q Tip  
and warm water to  
dissolve any stabiliser left  
on the edges
